New in April

- The RHIO's 2010 Annual Meeting showcased the impressive growth of the RHIO over the past year, and previewed advances planned for 2010. The presentation emphasized the critical value of health information exchange during transitions in care.
- Nancy Adams, Executive Director of the Monroe County Medical Society, was honored at the RHIO's Annual Meeting. Nancy received the Rochester RHIO 2009 Leadership Award for her efforts to build a Minor Consent Policy for NYS RHIOs, and for her leadership of the MCMS Service Bureau.
- The Rochester RHIO's new Provider Portal includes a link to the STEP Directory, a resource for emergency health providers throughout the region.

Coming Soon: Expansion of Data Providers and Data Types

The Rochester RHIO will be adding new sources of patient health information over the next few weeks. Both VHR users and physician practices who receive results electronically to their EHR will soon have instant access to test results and transcribed reports from:

- Medina Memorial Health Care System (May 2010)
- St. James Mercy Health System (June 2010)
- Westside Imaging Center (June 2010)
- Noyes Memorial Hospital – Lab Results & Transcribed Reports (June 2010)

The health information exchange will also include new types of data:

- Pre-hospital care documents from emergency service providers (May 2010)
- Advance Directives, including MOLST forms (June 2010)
- Enhanced health insurance eligibility information from Aetna (June 2010)

Updates

- **100 Physician practices are LIVE with a RHIO interface for electronic results delivery** – all lab, radiology and transcribed reports delivered automatically into their EHR.
 - EHRs Connected: Allscripts Professional, eClinical Works, HST, Medent, STI
 - EHRs in TEST phase: Greenway, McKesson, Sage
 - Other EHRs in process: NextGen, Seaquest
