



RHIO REPORT

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Important Updates

The RHIO's VHR (patient-centered query portal) now displays **ADT (hospital admission and discharge) notifications** under the tab marked "ADT". Users can also click on the ADT tab for pre-hospital reports from EMS services. The number hospitals and EMS squads providing these reports will grow throughout 2011.

Also new on the RHIO's VHR are patient **vital signs**. This information is currently populated by users of the Elysium EHR, and will soon be supplemented by data added by home monitors, health kiosks and physician practices (CCD exchange).

SOAPWare is the newest EHR vendor to connect to the Rochester RHIO. Physician practices who use SOAPWare can now receive all their lab, radiology and transcribed reports directly into their EHR through a single RHIO interface. SOAPWare joins the RHIO's list of 14 [connected EHR's](#).

The community's Heal 17 projects kicked-off in January. Unity Health System introduced the Diabetes Community Collaborative, a two year project to enhance Patient Centered Medical Home support for diabetic patients. Jordan Health Center launched a two year initiative to support their Patient Centered Medical Home for patients diagnosed with affective disorders. The Rochester RHIO is a partner in each of these projects.

The New York eHealth Collaborative (NYeC) Board of Directors invited Ted Kremer, Rochester RHIO Executive Director, to present the "Rochester Story" at a recent Board meeting. The NYeC leadership appreciated the opportunity to learn about Rochester's success in building a community health information exchange, and about our progress in reaching sustainability.

2010 in Review – Key Statistics in 4's

As of conclusion of the RHIO's 4th year, nearly **4000** healthcare providers and staff are authorized RHIO users.

400,000 patients have provided patient consent for at least one physician practice.

In 2010, **4,000,000** clinical reports were delivered directly to physician EHRs.

There are **44,000,000** clinical documents available on-line through the VHR.
